Despite having an area of just short of 100 m<sup>2</sup>, this gynaecology practice with disabled access boasts a complex room design. There are two examination rooms, a reception, a small laboratory, a disabled toilet for patients, a social room, changing room, staff toilet and two separate waiting areas, which all determine the extremely compact structure. The partition walls are mainly made of frosted glass, synthetic panels, sliding doors and curtain systems. Cupboards and storage space are integrated into the panels. The colours, shapes and surfaces are designed for ease of use and operation and are also part of the disabled-access design. Due to the expansion of the medical services offered, the practice has been extended to incorporate an additional waiting area.
